Crossing the deserts of Egypt

This place is so hot, not even Bedouin nomads venture into this part of the Sahara. It's a place where hardly any organisms exist, but it is insanely beautiful.

The “Dead Heart of Africa” in Chad

With a nickname like the *Dead heart of Africa*, Chad's not doing much to attract tourists. Yet Chad's lack of popular appeal comes from insufficient information and infrastructure, not from a lack of attractions like the martian-like landscapes of the Ennedi or the oases in the middle of dead sand.

The most remote inhabited island on Earth

If you haven't heard of Tristan da Cunha, don't feel bad, because only 270 citizens live on the most remotely inhabited island on Earth. The only way in or out is with an expensive ticket on one of the few fishing boats or polar research vessels that stop by to make sure it's still around.

Sailing around the world

The Clipper Round the World is a yearly race for complete amateur sailors. With a little training, you'll be taught to sail on the high seas. Yes, people have died, lost limbs, and the girl I met almost drowned. But if you've got the guts — and around \$20,000 — the high seas are yours.

Walking the jungles of Borneo

Borneo is the third-largest island in the world, covered mostly by a rainforest so thick that light doesn't reach many parts of the ground. Borneo's indigenous tribes inhabit the jungle today as they did centuries ago; this adventure makes the contact.

Momentum Adventure, skiing the whole world

Without your own helicopter and private jet, it would be impossible to ski in 8 countries and 3 continents, in about 17 days. You'll basically ski everywhere, where few people have skied, and in places like Japan and Greenland, you'll be heli-skiing. “Momentum adventure” can make it happen if you can afford the costly fee.

Enjoying Bhutan

Bhutan is located in a green section of the Himalayas with an equal amount of high altitudes and low-lying forests. Many opportunities exist for adventures, such as whitewater rafting the country's world-class rapids that are only now becoming known to the rest of the world. Some people opt to explore the lesser-known parts of Bhutan's countryside.

Afghanistan

Remoteness, inaccessibility, and high threats of danger make this a tempting experience for people who like taking risks, but it's not recommended to take your loved ones. Despite the ongoing war, travellers like Daniel Britt go and come back safe from this place.
